Horse Boarding Agreement

This is a legal document in conjunction with the established Barn Rules and the Ranch Boarding Agreement. This agreement is for those boarding not under a trainer's care or training program.

1. No running or loud noise is permitted. Noise can spook horses and can lead to accidents.
2. Appropriate footwear should prioritize protecting your feet from potential hazards: Shoes should fully cover your feet and preferably extend to cover your ankles to prevent injury.
3. No jumping is permitted without the supervision of a trainer while on the premises.
4. No riding horses in the barn aisles: This is a safety concern and is to prevent disruption of others working in the barn.
5. No entrance of stalls without permission: This is a basic courtesy and a safety measure.
6. Keep the aisles clear: Do not leave equipment or belongings in the aisles. Tack trunks are permitted.
7. Respect barn hours: Adhere to the barn's operating hours.
8. Respect others: Be mindful of trainers, other boarders, their horses, and the barn staff.
9. Any safety concerns should be communicated to the barn owner, not barn staff. The best communication is via text with a photo (858)414-4982.
10. Do not feed other people's horses: This can lead to digestive problems and other health issues.
11. Arena etiquette: Be aware of and follow the rules of the riding arena; this includes passing other riders on the correct side.
12. Yield to lessons: Ask trainer(s) for approval before entering any arena; lessons take precedence.
13. Horses are to be taken out daily: All horses must be taken out of stall/corral daily for exercise.
14. Farrier or vet visits: Owner must be present at the facility for these visits.
15. Turnout usage: Maximum time is limited to 30 minutes in the morning.
16. Round lunge pens: These are for lunging ONLY.
17. Horse Walker: Ranch trainers and grooms are the only people permitted to put horses on the walker.
18. Vet Care Authorization: In my absence, Owner authorizes Ranch staff or designated person(s) to obtain emergency care for my horse(s). This permission provides the Ranch staff the authority to take whatever action(s) are deemed necessary to ensure the welfare of the animal. Ranch staff or the designated person(s) are authorized to obtain emergency medical care for my horse up to an amount of \$_____.
